

The admission process for the 2018–2019 course begins on December 1st, 2017 and remains open until the program is full. We recommend that you start the admission process before finishing your pre-University studies.

1 Register with your email and password and complete the admission form at www.salleurl.edu/form/eng

2 Fill in the requested data. In the documentation section you must attach:

2.1 Digital image of your passport or other valid ID (front and back).

2.2 Digital “passport style” photo (recent).

2.3 Motivation letter explaining the reasons why you want to study your chosen bachelor Degree program at La Salle Campus Barcelona (if you choose to do the Degree in English, the letter must be in English).

2.4 Academic documentation:

Recommendation letter written by a tutor, head teacher, course director or teacher from your last year of studies.

A) If you are studying in the Spanish education system:

A1. Baccalaureate: The first and second year of baccalaureate grades (to date) and the grades for the PAU (University entrance exam) if you already have them.

A2. Vocational Studies: CFGS (*Ciclos formativos de Grado Superior*) first and second year grades (to date).

B) If you are studying in another country which does not follow the Spanish education system:

B1. Diploma of International Baccalaureate (IB Diploma). Education System of EU, China, Switzerland or other countries with bilateral agreements:

- Grades of the last two years of study (to date).

- Accreditation form of the National Distance Education University (UNED – Universidad Nacional de Educación a Distancia) www.uned.es/accesoUE. Students can obtain this on completion of their studies.

B2. Other educational systems:

- Grades of last two years of study (to present date)

- Official recognition of final Spanish Baccalaureate certificate, issued by the Spanish Ministry of Education. To obtain this certificate, contact the Spanish Embassy in your country or the Departament d'Educació (the Institute of Education) in Barcelona.

C) If you are studying, or have studied, at another University. To do this, you will need to legalise your academic records previously. You are required to send your academic record from the institution, clearly stating the program name and the detail of the content of each subject. Present a document form.

2.5 B2 or higher certificate of a foreign language (if available).

2.6 International students (coming from international education systems).

Must include a receipt of the payment of 100 € (non-refundable) as admission process fees. In the FIELD Description:

2.7 If you plan to study the Bachelor Degree Program in English.

If you plan to study the bachelor Degree program in English and your pre-University studies were not in English (minimum 2 years), you must submit documentation which certifies your level of English. The accreditations that we recognize are: TOEFL (iBT) 90-110, Cambridge Advanced English or IELTS 6-7. If you are not in possession of an official English language accreditation you will have to do an English interview with us.

2.8 Evaluation of the candidates.

The evaluation is individual and you should submit:

A) Bachelor Degree in Architecture:

A book with the following 6 drawings: A horse and a dinosaur, a person sitting down reading a newspaper, a Greek temple, the interior of a living room in perspective (it should include large windows, sofa and armchairs, table, television and a bookcase), a bicycle, a fishermen boat in perspective. This exercise is to evaluate your drawing skills, as well as your capacity to observe, understand and interpret the environment.

B) Bachelor Degree in Engineerings, Technologies, Digital Business, Design and Innovation or the Double Degree in International Computer Engineering + Management of Business and Technology:

A digital copy of a research work (end of course work), related to the engineering environment during your pre-University studies or a 2-page text where you can develop a technological idea that you would like to be able to implement and an interview with the Degree Coordinator.

C) Bachelor Degree in Business:

A level test to evaluate your knowledge and skills.

D) Bachelor Degree in Animation & VFX:

A Storyboard of 8 frames, visualising a short story and, alternatively, you can also come up with your own character and send us a graphic design and/or a text description.

3 Personal interview

If the Admission Committee considers it necessary, you may be asked to attend an interview at our campus or do one online.

4 Acceptance

You will be informed of your acceptance on the Bachelor Degree program within 15 days of sending the documentation or the interview.

5 Scholarships

If you would like to apply for a scholarship, you should go to the online admission process and request it submitting the correct documentation required according to the type of scholarship. It is only possible to apply for a scholarship once you have been admitted to the program.

6 Reserve your place

A payment of 1.000€ is required in order to reserve your place on the program. 100€ covers the administration cost of opening your academic record and the remaining 900€ goes towards your tuition fees. These payments are only refundable in costs of the student being unable to complete the admission process (e.g. failing to meet the La Salle entry requirements).
