


The importance of tourism and the historical and multicultural role of the city make it easy to hear other languages such as English, French, Italian, Portuguese, German, Arabic...

Barcelona has a Mediterranean climate, with hot summers and cool winters. Today the city has nine beaches and a bathing area that occupy more than 4.2 linear kilometers of coastline, as well as extensive green areas around it.

Although it is a big city, it is very easy to get around by public transport or on foot.

The cost of living in Barcelona is like other European cities, less expensive than Paris and London, but more expensive than Lisbon and Athens.

Barcelona Transport

Barcelona has an excellent public transport network that includes the metro, buses, tram, trains (FGC AND RENFE) and taxis. The fastest and cheapest way to move within the city is by metro and bus.

Metro

The Barcelona Metro has eight lines (five conventional lines and three automatic), 156 stations and more than 140 trains running at rush hour. It also integrates the Montjuïc funicular into its service.

The Barcelona metro opens every day at 5 in the morning, except on days when it runs all night (continuous service).

Bus

TMB offers bus service throughout the day, from Monday to Sunday. Some lines work by frequency of passage and others work by schedule.

The schedules of the bus lines vary depending on the type of day of the week: working, Saturday or holiday. If none of these options appears, the line does not run on that type of day (there are bus lines that do not run on Saturdays or holidays, and others, on the other hand, that only run on holidays).

During the night, the Nitbus company offers night bus service in Barcelona and in the first metropolitan ring with 17 lines.

The intercity bus service connects Barcelona with the rest of the municipalities in the metropolitan area.

Before arriving...

Visa application

For non-European students, it is an essential requirement to obtain a student visa to reside in Spain.

The visa application must be presented in person, on an official model, at the Spanish diplomatic mission or consular office in whose demarcation the foreigner resides.

It is suggested to consult the complete list of requirements on the official pages of the Spanish Consulate in your country of residence since the requirements may vary depending on the country.

From La Salle University-URL you will receive an acceptance letter certifying that you have been admitted to study at the institution so that you can attach it to the other requirements of your visa application.

Important note:

- If the duration of your studies does not exceed 6 months, the visa will be sufficient as a document to remain in the country.
- If the duration of your studies exceeds 6 months, you must request the TIE document (Foreigner Identity Card) upon arrival.

Health insurance

It is very important for the foreign student to have private international medical insurance (without co-payments, without deficiencies) arranged with an insurance entity authorized to operate in Spain.

The International Office assists and guides in the processing of NIE/TIE residence permits once the students are in Barcelona.

Census

All people who live in the city of Barcelona have the obligation to be registered. The Census Document is the municipal registry of the entire population of the city and being registered is a mandatory requirement to be able to access public services such as health or education. In addition, registration is also a mandatory requirement for certain procedures related to the Immigration Law (NIE/TIE).

Non-European citizens to be able to register need a rental contract of at least 6 months. The census is one of the documents necessary for the issuance of the NIE.

Registration must be done at the town hall of residence.

How to request it?

Registration in the Central Registry of Foreigners (NIE)

Citizens of the European Union, the European Economic Area and Switzerland, whether they are self-employed or employed, students, pensioners, or family members (spouse, ascendant or descendant), can reside in Spain without a special permit. Likewise, when the period of residence is greater than three months, they are obliged to request in person, before the Barcelona Foreigners' Office, registration in the Central Registry of Foreigners where a Registration Certificate will be issued immediately, containing the name, nationality, address, NIE and the date of registration.

How to request it?

TIE (Foreign Identity Card). For non-European citizens.

The Foreigner Identity Card is the unique and exclusive document intended to provide documentation to foreigners in a situation of legal permanence in Spain, for which purpose the recipients of the same must complete the procedures established for its delivery. All foreigners who have been issued a visa or authorization to remain in Spain for a period of more than six months have the right and duty to obtain the Foreigner Identity Card, which they must request in person within a period of one month from your entry into Spain or from when the authorization is granted or becomes valid, respectively.

The TIE student card is the document that replaces the student visa when you are already in Spain. This permit is renewed every year and the term to present the documentation is from 60 days before to the day before the expiration date. However, the law also allows the TIE to be renewed within 90 days after the expiration of the card.
