ACADEMIC PROGRAMME

SEMESTER I

Project Management Essentials

You will gain an understanding of **the basic principles of project management** by defining a **common, cross-cutting framework** for any project and industry. This subject focuses on scope, deadlines and costs.

Business Management

You will internalise the foundational knowledge of project management that every professional should have by studying the different knowledge areas to observe how they affect changes in the business environment and defining the keys to success in organisations.

Cost Management and Investment Analysis

You will master the **necessary skills for budgeting and decision-making in investment projects** based on criteria of economic viability, financial soundness and profitability.

Integrated Project Management

You will define the framework and address the different **areas** of the Triple Constraint. With this subject, you will learn in detail other often overlooked management processes that also play a decisive role in the success of a project.

Leadership Skills and Team Management

You will learn to identify the priorities inherent to the role of project manager, implementing a process of continuous personal improvement by developing key competencies in the achievement of project objectives, quality of work and client relations.

SEMESTER II

Business Project Management

You will learn to identify and plan projects to launch new physical and digital products and services, and to implement organisational restructuring improvements by applying business vision and strategic decision-making.

Agile Project Management

You will put into practice all the knowledge gained throughout the Master to solve real cases. You will discover the most popular **agile project management methods**, application environments and techniques (Scrum, Kanban, Lean, etc.) focusing on customer needs, adaptability to change and interaction between people to maximise team performance and results.

Change Management

You will study the **main** project management **methodologies** from the perspective of **change management** to gain a comprehensive understanding of their applicability.

Master's Final Project

This module is designed to **consolidate all the competencies developed** throughout the Master's. You will analyse, argue and present **a case in the field of project management under the guidance of a mentor**.

ELECTIVE SUBJECTS*

Pharma - Biotech Projects 🛛 🆓 🛄

You will analyse the **R&D** environment in which these projects take place and study the **application of the project management techniques** covered in the Master.

Digital Transformation Projects 🛛 🍄 🖵

You will train to **identify and leverage new digital opportunities to develop projects** that collectively will make up a company's digital transformation plan.

You will study the **key factors in managing different types of construction projects**, analysing the strengths that companies in the sector must have to compete in the current context.

Sustainable Projects 🛛 🛄

We train **future leaders in the implementation of sustainable solutions**. Sustainable projects can help reduce costs, improve brand image and increase company profitability. With this subject, you will build essential management skills and knowledge for a sustainable future.

Startup Projects (in English) 🖓 🛄

You will focus on **entrepreneurship and the start-up of a new business project**, where ideas transform into business models, which you will test through **interactions with potential customers, partners and suppliers**.

Cyber-Physical Projects

You will be trained in the management of highly complex projects that combine the physical and digital worlds. You will acquire transversal management skills in emerging technologies.

Lean Project Management 🖗

Lean project management first emerged in the 1990s with the book *The Machine that Changed the World* by James Womack and Daniel Joss. Although it was originally the name of the Toyota Production System, it has grown to be considered a **global system applicable to any industry or field**.

International Projects 2004

You will train to **manage international projects**. With this subject, you will gain the necessary skills and knowledge to operate in a range of cultural and socio-economic environments, and you will be able to handle the complexities that arise when working in an international context.


