

Architecture Workshop in Barcelona

The **13th edition** of La Salle-URL Architecture Workshop wants students to reflect on the knowledge of the city, both at the urban and architectural level, to design an architecture that will last in time, and **understand the traditional architectural solutions** of conceptual and formal quality in relation to the place, climate, material, and environment.

The material character of the construction of architecture is relevant in the history of architecture. **Catalan modernism elevates tradition** and, for the first time, highlights the patents of new technologies that **coexist between the traditional and the modern**. Antoni Gaudí carried out, without consciously or deliberately proposing it, a synthesis between the most orthodox tradition and the most radical experimentalism, born of creative independence and a vision that arose on the margins of contemporary conventions.

The Casa Milà building "La Pedrera" (1906–1912) summarizes the freest creativity, what we can consider the most unexpected invention. It will be difficult to find an architectural work that offers an image and spaces that project, together with the fulfilment of the **functional** needs inherent to this **art,** a vision that transcends, like this one, the architectural. The workshop will allow us to understand this transition of the architecture of the early twentieth century.

You will reflect on **construction systems**, while using **sustainability criteria** in construction and **understanding architectural space** and the relationship between the local and the international.


You will **improve your skills** and apply them to the **projects** you will carry out during the course.
